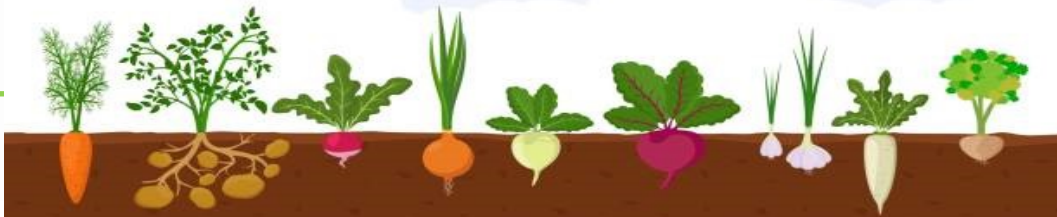
- learn about plant science and garden development
